"Now You Know" Campaign Launches



One of the biggest challenges with fighting COVID-19 is getting good information about the virus, how it spreads, how to stay healthy and what to do if you test positive into the hands of the public. Much of the information is only available in print. Many individuals in our community struggle with literacy.

In an effort to provide short, informative videos that can be used on social media as well as in public service announcements, Virginia Garcia launched a new series called "Now You Know". These short clips will cover topics such as wearing a mask, social distancing and

contact tracing and will run in both English and Spanish.

The first video was released this week in honor or National Health Center Week and featured KGW anchor Stephanie Stricklen. Future videos will include VG staff as well as partners from around the community.

Outreach Updates



The Yamhill County screening event took place on Tuesday, August 11 and was a free event open to the community in partnership with the Housing Authority of Yamhill County and Workforce Yamhill.

The event was widely successful, bringing more than 300 individuals to be screened. Virginia Garcia was able to provide screening services to 339 individuals in just over 4 hours.
