## COVID-19 Updates & Data as of November 6

Governor Brown held a press conference on Friday afternoon where she has announced a “pause” on social activities in five Oregon counties.

The pause, which applies to Multnomah, Marion, Jackson, Malheur and Umatilla counties, will start Wednesday, November 11 and remain in effect until the day before Thanksgiving. Depending on case counts on Monday, November 9, restrictions may go into effect for Washington, Clackamas, Linn, Baker and Union counties as well.

The pause suspends visits at long-term care facilities; encourages working at home; sets new restaurant capacity limits to 50 people, including customers and staff; and recommends not gathering with people outside your household, or capping group sizes at six.
